**Sunday Double One Way Imperial Clout, shooting method 2**

**50+ group archers,** can shoot one distance less than above for tassels. Records for 50+ groups are only for standard distances.

**AWARDS:** Trophies presented for combined scores for both days in all bow styles.  
Medals awarded for each days round.
